Pat Moore, Kindred, North Dakota

Pat has been carving and painting for over 35 years. She has traveled throughout the US sharing her techniques & talents through woodcarving classes & seminars. Pat has won many “Best of Show” ribbons including World Ward completion, Dayton, and Sacramento shows in 2018. Pat is noted for her attention to detail & great use of color in her woodcarvings.

January 31st - From 1 PM to 5 PM. Pat will lead a free carving seminar on “carving eyes”.

- Bring plain tools “U” and “V” gouges. No registration required.

January 31st - 7 PM. Pat presents “Tips and Tricks of Painting Wood”. Free to anyone.

Includes techniques she uses with paints, sealers, brushes, etc.

February 1st & 2nd - Carve and paint a penguin rough-out with Pat. 9 AM to 5 PM each day.

Cost is \$125 which includes rough-out. Pat will bring acrylic paints and brushes.

Registration required. Class size limited to 12.

Rick Jensen, Crookston, Minnesota

Rick wrote the first published book on carving cottonwood bark houses. Rick was also named “Carver of the Year” by Carving Illustrated magazine in 2016. Rick has traveled throughout the US leading seminars on carving bark houses. Rick is also noted for his blue ribbon basswood Santa carvings.

February 28th - From 1 PM to 5 PM. Rick will lead a carving of a stylized basswood goose with two young ones. Free but small charge for the blanks. No registration.

February 28th - 7 PM. Rick leads the program discussing different mediums & carving techniques. Rick will bring carvings of bark and other woods for display.

March 1st & 2nd - Carve a flat back bark house that hangs on a wall or sits on a shelf. It will be approximately 8-9” long. Bring mostly gouges, 5 & 7 sweeps, small v tools.

Cost is \$120.00 plus charge for the blank. Registration required. Class size limited to 12.
