A - PYROGRAPHY - Brenda Lodermeier

Brenda has been carving & working with pyrography for the past 12 years. She is an active member of the Central MN Woodcarvers Association and on the Board of Directors for the Rio Grande Woodcarving Show in Mission Texas. If you are a beginner or advanced pyrography student, this is the class for you.

Let's learn or renew the basics and work with different techniques, emphasizing your style and completing projects on a variety of wood species. Instructor will discuss preparation of wood, patterns, and use of burners including variety of tips and cleaning. Students are encouraged to bring additional lighting, graphite paper and their burning units. Many patterns and design available. Student may start with a barn project or bring one of their own. I have many patterns to choose from. Brenda is an authorized Colwood Dealer with burners, tips, wood and supplies for purchase.

B - RELIEF, WOODBURNING & PAINTING - Fred and Elaine Stenman

Students will learn the techniques developed by Elaine and Fred, which combine low relief carving with details that are wood burned. The carvings are painted with very thin acrylics and stained with oil paint. Tool techniques for full sized gouges and wood burning tools along with elements of design will be taught.

Students may select from three of the Stenmans' original designs:

1. A building and fence post are carved. Details woodburned. Background will change to due to limited time.
2. A rainbow trout jumping. The fish is carved.
3. A common loon swimming (carved). Woodburned grasses.

The projects will be executed in basswood with the bark remaining on the edge to create a natural frame. The paints and brushes are provided. We encourage students who are new to the class to do our low red barn or cabin relief as they are a great learning experience.

Tools

Padded 22"-24" Stool (Especially for those with back problems).

#3-35 mm Swiss Made. The Flexcut #220799 1/4" or a Stubai #4/35 may be substituted for this gouge.

#3 sweep Swiss Made, #3 sweep Denny (or other) gouges in various sizes from 10-20mm. If you use Stubai or other brands, you will find that you may require a #4 sweep, as most brands have less sweep than the Swiss made.

A thin bladed bench /detail knife or a bent chip carving knife.

Various other size gouges- palm or full size that you may have.

Clamp on light. (We will bring some lights)



A good wood burning tool, such as a Detailmaster, Colwood or Optima. Note: Instructors will bring a few large #3 gouges for use in class.

Students new to our style of carving, should practice woodburning details on a 6" X 9" printed board during the class.

C - OUTHOUSE CLASS - Ken Ramler

Using a basswood cutouts, students will carve, burn, and paint an outhouse or cabin about 5 inches tall. Trees may be added to the back if desired. This is an all-skill level carving using v-tools, gouges, and knives.

Cost: \$30 basswood cutouts \$8-10 Skill: Beginner to Advanced Class size: 14

D - PHEASANT TAIL FEATHER - Mary Kimball

Learn to carve, woodburn and paint a life size pheasant tail feather. All painting supplies are provided. Wood burner needed for class.

**Cost: \$35.00 Skill level: Beginner to Advanced
Blanks: \$10.00 Class size: 8**



E - BARK CARVING - Derek Epping

Make a light house or a whimsy house. You will need glove and a thumb guard. I use my knife, v-tool, u-gouge, number 3, 9, and bring your Woodburner. I use a sharpie to use instead of a pencil. If you have a small hand drill bring that, if not, I'll have a drill to use for the class. Bring a strap to strap your knives. Bring a cord just in case.

F - SAINT URHO OR SANTA OR CHRISTMAS ELF - John Overby

Tools - Knife and v-tool. The roughout is a bandsaw cut out. **Supplies to bring.** Acrylic paints colors are tomatoe spice, autum brown, buttermilk, gray, burnt umber, moss green and christmas colors. If you have a muffin pan and inexpensive brushes please bring them as they will be used to mix your paints.

G - OLD WORLD CHIP CARVING - Jan Jenson



Learn to do Old World Chip Carving with 3 easy cuts! Glue the pattern on and start carving right away! First, do a practice piece to learn the technique. Students may then choose to carve a design on a single or two-deck card box, a napkin holder, a trivet, or one of the several other small projects. All will be available for purchase. You will need a good chip carving knife and a good light. All other supplies will be provided. There will be many designs from which to choose from Jan's books.
