**CAPITAL AREA CARVERS OF WISCONSIN (CACW)  
JUDGED CARVING COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

**CATEGORIES**

Novice, Intermediate, and Open

Ribbons will be awarded for first, second and third place in each category as determined by the judges.

**GROUPS**

Birds	Caricature	Canes/walking sticks	Ornaments
Fish	Santa	Pyrography Painted/unpainted	
Animals/Mammals/Reptiles	Chip Carving	Gourds	Mythical/Religious
Realistic Human	Interpretive/Stylized	Relief	Groupings

Ribbons will be awarded for first, second and third place in each group as determined by the judges.

**COMPETITION ELIGIBILITY**

- ✓ Only persons who have rented a table at this show may enter pieces in the competition.
- ✓ All entries for Judged Competition must be at the competition display tables no later than 8:30 AM.
- ✓ 2 (two) entries per person, per category will be accepted.

If a contestant questions which category/group item(s) should be entered in; The Competition Chairperson will determine which category/group item(s) go into.

- ✓ All items must be your own work and must have been completed within the past 2 (two) years. Your name or initial on the carving must be covered.
- ✓ All work must be hand crafted (no CNC, Laser, etc.)

**Novice** – At our show, this category is intended for new carvers or carvers with little carving experience. After winning two blue ribbons in this category, you must move up to the Intermediate category. **Exhibitors who sell items, carving instructors or anyone who has judged a carving show or vendors are not eligible for this category.**

**Intermediate** – At our show, a contestant must enter this category when two blue ribbons have been earned in the Novice Category. When you have won two blue ribbons in the Intermediate Category you must move up to the Open category; **Vendors selling items at our show, professional carving instructors (those who are paid to teach carving).**

**Open** – At our show, a contestant must enter the Open category after you have won two blue ribbons in the Intermediate category. **All contestants are eligible to enter the Open category.**

**Best of Show Award** – In addition to each of the category awards, a “Best of Show Award” without any qualifications of category or place will be awarded as determined by the judges. A gold ribbon will be presented to the winner.

The Best of Show winning item, if also a first place winner in any of the categories will not receive the ribbon in the category. Instead ribbons will be moved down one spot, i.e., if the Best of Show winner was also a ribbon winner in a category, the next highest vote-getter in that category will receive that ribbon.
