Upcoming Seminars

- **The 3rd Annual John Engler Seminar** will be held at the Lincoln Center in Stevens Point, WI. There will be a (3) day woodcarving class (**Monday, Tuesday, & Wednesday, September 15, 16, & 17, 2025**) and a (1) day painting class (**Thursday September 18, 2025**). He specializes in medium relief woodcarving finishing them off with watercolors. Cost of the seminar, Carving only - \$210.00 members and \$225.00 non-members. Cost of Carving & Painting - \$280.00 for members and \$300.00 for non-members. Blanks would cost between \$40.00 and \$45.00. Pay John for blanks at start of class. Check out his website www.johnenglerwoodcarving.com. We have **(12)** carvers already paid. **The class is full.**
- **Vic Hood** of Franklin, TN will be holding a (5) day carving **seminar** after the 2025 show. Vic specializes in carving a realistic human bust in Butternut. The project will be smaller than life size. Vic has been carving and teaching for over 25 years. The seminar will be from Monday thru

Friday September 22, 23, 24, 25, & 26, 2025 in the Workshop of the Lincoln Center, 1519 Water Street, Stevens Point, WI. Hours will be 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. The cost of the Seminar will be \$350.00 plus blank for members of the Wisconsin River Woodcarvers and \$400.00 plus blank for non-members. Blank will cost between \$70.00 and \$80.00. Pay Vic for blank. The maximum number of students is (10). We have **(6)** carvers paid at this time. **Registration form is included in the newsletter or on the club website www.wisconsinriverwoodcarvers.org.**

- Because of all the fun that we had, we will be having the **5th Annual Floyd Rhadigan Seminar**. It will be held at the Lincoln Center in Stevens Point, WI on **Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday, April 28, 29, & 30, 2026**. Cost is \$150.00 plus roughout(s) for Wisconsin River Woodcarvers members and \$160.00 plus roughouts(s) for Non-Members. The cost for the seminar has stayed the same from 2022 to 2026. Cost of roughouts is between \$15.00 and \$40.00. Pay Floyd for roughouts at start of class. **Registration form is attached to this newsletter, or available on the club website www.wisconsinriverwoodcarvers.org.** We have **(4)** carvers already paid.

2025 Show

- **Show Committee** consists of Jerry Trzebiatowski, Greg Wirtz, Ashten Brown, Libby Wirtz, Ron O'Kray, and Mahala Earnhart. Jerry Uher is an advisor to the show committee.
- The Show Committee met at 3:00 PM on Wednesday August 13th at the 1st United Church of Christ, The Show Committee will meet at 3:00 PM on August 27th, September 3rd, & September 10th at the First United Church of Christ.
- We have **(129)** Tables paid for at this time and **(6)** that say the "Check is in the Mail". The following vendors have already agreed to be at the show: Badger State Blades, Don Butler (The Carving Glove Guy), Jim Hart (Wood vendor), Karen Henderson (Spoons), John Dunkle (Dunkle Knives), The Whittling Shack (Chris Whillock), Moore Wood & Roughouts, Chief Books LLC, Charlene Lynam, My Chip Carving (Marty Leenhouts, Fred & Elaine Stenman, and Stadlander Woodcarvings.
- A discussion was held at the December 11th Show Committee meeting about allowing other items than woodcarvings on show tables. The current show rules state: *"This is a woodcarving competition; we request that at least 60% of your tables(s) be for woodcarvings"*. The Show Committee discussed this clause and decided to allow: woodworking (e.g. cutting boards, boxes, and wood turnings as long as the items are handcrafted by the craftsman selling the item.) We want quality items **(NO IMPORTS)**. We have (1) woodworker signed up at this time.
- We will have an ornament tree. When you are carving ornaments, carve an extra one or two for the Christmas tree. They can be given to either Jerry, Greg, or Ron at any time. The tree and ornaments will be raffled off at the 2025 show.
- The following carvers had agreed to be judges at the show: Tom Kautz, Gene Bengal, April Bird, John Engler, Gerald Lesch, and Joe Longo.
- Because this is the 30th Anniversary of the Wisconsin River Woodcarvers, we will have **"Polo Shirts"** for sale. A form is attached to the newsletter. Available colors can be seen on the club website.

- **30th ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATIVE KNIVES:** The Wisconsin River Woodcarvers Show Committee has agreed that Badger State Knives will make (50) knives with a **1 ½' X ¼" long detail blade**. One side of the knife will have the Badger State Blades logo and the other side will have Wisconsin River Woodcarvers and 95 / 25. The handle will be of Cherry wood. The knives will have a leather blade cover made by Gene Graham of Smyrna, TN. The knives will have serial numbers. Sorry, Greg Wirtz has already purchased Serial # 01. The cost of the blade will be \$60.00 and have to be preordered. A picture of the knife is attached in "Show & Tell" section of this newsletter. A form for ordering knives is attached. We have **(22)** knives paid for at this time. Greg Wirtz, Chet James, Jerry Trzebiatowski, and Ron O'Kray each have (1) Commemorative Knife if you would like to see the finished product.
- Badger State blades will donate an additional (10) commemorative knives with a **2" straight blade**. Best of Novice, Best of Intermediate, and Best of Advanced will get one. (2) knives will go on the Raffle, (1) will go to the winner of "Whittling Contest", (1) will go to winner of the "People's Choice, and (2) will be given out at the Saturday night banquet. Read next paragraph.
- In order to get more pieces into competition, Ashten Brown of Badger State Blades came up with an idea. With a table rental, a carver can put (6) pieces in competition with (2) in any one category. A carver can enter more than (6) pieces in competition for an additional charge of \$5.00 per carving. This year carvings can be entered into competition that have been finished after September 20, 2021. If a carver would enter (6) or more pieces into competition, they would be given a ticket for a Wisconsin River Woodcarvers / Badger State Blades commemorative knife with a **2" straight blade**. This knife would be different from the commemorative knife that the club will be selling.
- We also will have lamp segments. Ron has cutout the segments. Contact Ron for the segments. The segments are 2" X 2" X 3" with a 16mm hole in the center. You can carve, woodburn, or paint your segment. We will need the segments completed prior to the show. We will assemble the segments into a table lamp that will be raffled off at the 2025 show. (2) of the lamps are completed. Depending of the number of blocks returned, we possibly could have (5) lamps to raffle off this year.
- The Wisconsin River Woodcarvers had a Tent at the "Rudolph Old Tractor Show" on Saturday August 9th. The heavy rain caused us to pick up early, but we did give out one Show Flyer.

New Business

- We need help on Friday September 19th at the Holiday Inn to help set the show up. If you can help contact Ron O'Kray of Jerry Trzebiatowski.
- There being no other business President Greg Wirtz asked for a motion to adjourn. Jerry Trzebiatowski made the motion and seconded by Libby Wirtz. All in attendance approved. Meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM.

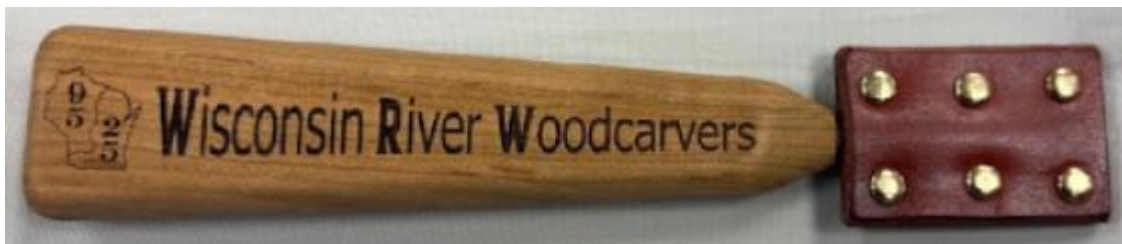

VIC HOOD SEMINAR

Vic will be teaching, "Carving a realistic human bust in Butternut". The project will be smaller than life-size.

Vic has been carving and teaching for over 25 years. In that time he has won over 100 awards for his work. In addition to winning awards, Vic has been asked to do a piece for the White House and in 2011 was the Woodcarving Illustrated Carver of the Year. He also had a 30-minute woodcarving show on the DIY network and published two books on carving. The first book "Carving Found Wood" won the Independent Book Publisher's "Book of the Year" award.

His commitment to teaching woodcarving is illustrated by his students winning more First Place and "Best of Group" in the International Woodcarver's Congress "Instructor Assisted" category than any other instructor ever at this show. Many of his students have gone on to win "Best of Show" awards all over the country.

The 2025 Commemorative Knife has been planned to celebrate our 30th Anniversary. We are expecting a very good response for knife orders and will be taking orders until August 1, 2025. Badger State Blades will manufacture the knife out of high-quality steel. The blade will be 1 ½" X ¼", because in polling club members, this is what most carvers wanted. The handle will be made of "Cherry" wood with "Badger State Blades" logo on one side and "Wisconsin River Woodcarvers" and the "State logo with 1995 / 2025" on the other side. The writing on the handles will be laser engraved. The knives will have a Serial number. All knives will come with a leather blade guard made by Gene Graham of Smyrna, TN. The cost of the knives will be \$60.00 each.
